

## **CYP Deputy CEO awarded a Winston Churchill Fellowship**



Bernardine Denigan, Deputy CEO of Cape York Partnerships, has been awarded a Winston Churchill scholarship to study Indigenous participation in education.

The Winston Churchill Memorial Trust, established as one of Churchill's last requests, provides annual Fellowships for Australians to travel overseas to experience new opportunities, to make contacts with the best in their fields and to bring the experience back to benefit Australia.

Bernardine has won the Vincent Fairfax Churchill Fellowship and will spend two months in the USA to ascertain methods for increasing the effectiveness of Indigenous education. She will spend two months in Nebraska, New York, Mississippi, Utah and Philadelphia.
